**INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES SEEKING ADMISSION**

Any candidate of the state having passed H.S (+2) examination of Tripura Board of Secondary Education or its equivalent including National Open School shall be eligible for admission to the 1<sup>st</sup> year TDC/TDCH in Belonia College subject to restriction of subject combination as laid down in Tripura University regulations. Candidates are required to submit attested copies of documents along with the application form duly filled in. Original documents are to be produced at the time of submission of application form as well as the time of admission.

Following courses are available in Belonia College for the Academic Session 2010-2011

**HONOURS COURSES (Figures in the bracket show intake capacity approved by Tripura University)**

- A. Physical Science: Physics ( 25), Chemistry (25) , Mathematics ( 25) and Statistics (10).
- B. Life Science: Botany (25), Zoology (25) and Physiology(25).
- C. Humanities & Social Sciences: Bengali (60), English (50) , Sanskrit(60), Political Science (60), Philosophy (60), Education ( 50), History (50), Geography (40),
- D. Commerce: Accountancy (50)

**E. SUBJECTS IN PASS COURSES (TDC)**

All the subjects mentioned in the Honours Courses irrespective of Physical Sciences, Life Sciences, Arts and Commerce are available for TDC Pass Courses also. Besides, B.A/ B.SC courses include *Economics, Environmental Science and Physical Education* as elective subject. Number of seats in *Physical Education and Environmental Science and Statistics* is 10 each.

- F. Self-financing courses : BCA ( 20), DCA (30) .

**Eligibility for Admission.**

1. A candidate opting TDC Course for B.A./B.Sc./B.Com Degree shall choose any three subjects, subject to the College restrictions besides foundation course.
2. Preference to admission will be given to fresh candidates passed in the current year ( 2010) followed by the candidates passed in 2009 and 2008 respectively depending on the availability of seats.
3. i) For Honours in any Subject a candidate must have obtained 40% marks in aggregate and 45% marks in the subject in which he /she seeks Honours  
or  
35% marks in the aggregate and 50% marks in the subject at the H.S.(+ 2) stage Examination .  
ii) *Honours will be given on the basis of a Total score which shall be Total marks( Maximum 500 marks) obtained by the student plus marks of the subject in which student seeks Honours provided all other conditions are satisfied.*
4. A candidate who appeared but could not obtain pass mark in any subject at the H.S.(+ 2) stage Examination will not be allowed to take up that subject in the Degree Course, nor Honours can be offered in a subject in which the candidate passed in compartmental Examination.
5. Any one securing 50% marks in aggregate shall be eligible for taking Honours in a subject which he /she did not study in H.S (+2) examination or its equivalent subject to restriction as per Tripura University rules.
6. No student shall be allowed to prosecute two full-time courses offered by the University simultaneously.

7. For taking up Botany, Zoology , Physiology in TDC/TDCH courses , a student will have to pass Biology, Physics and Chemistry in H.S.(+2) examination or its equivalent examination and must have passed Mathematics for admission to B.Sc ( Physical Science)
8. A candidate shall not be allowed to offer more than two language subjects as elective.
9. A candidate seeking admission to B.Com. (Honours ) course:
  - i) Must have secured at least 45% marks in Mathematics at the Madhyamik or its equivalent Examination.  
Or
  - ii) Must have passed Mathematics in H.S. (+2) stage or its equivalent Examination.  
Or
  - iii) Must have passed two Commerce papers
- 9 A candidate seeking admission to Geography Honours will have to pass Geography, or Physics or Chemistry or Mathematics or Economics or Economic Geography in H.S (+2) or its equivalent.
- 10 If a candidate desires to take Environmental Science as one of the elective subject, he/she will have to study two more elective subjects out of Zoology, Botany, Human Physiology, Physics and Chemistry.
11. State Government Reservation Policy will govern reservation for SC/ST for both Honours and Pass subjects (Environmental Science and Physical Education).
12. Application forms, which are not duly filled in/ incomplete, shall summarily be rejected.
13. Choice of combinations, however, is subject to University/College regulations.
14. Candidates seeking Honours course can give two preferences one as 1<sup>st</sup> Preference and the other as 2<sup>nd</sup> preference. Second preference application may be a xerox copy of the original application but a mark sheet as well as a caste certificate should support it.
15. Once a candidate is admitted to an Honours course, he /she will not be allowed to change the said Honours subject course and this will be strictly adhered to. However a student will be allowed to change elective subject/stream within 30 days from the date of admission.
16. Admission to self-financing courses (BCA /DCA) is guided by separate rules for which forms are to be collected.
17. All admissions will be provisional subjects to the fulfillment of conditions and rules of the college and university.
18. There shall not be any marks bar for ST/SC students being admitted against ST/SC reserved seats or quota.
19. Students desirous to take admission from waiting list will have to know their position from the college notice board everyday positively.
20. List of selected / waiting listed candidates will be published on **29-06-2010**.
